

MONITORS: IEM Rack with 16 Channel Split

- All instruments and vocals run into Blueprint Tokyo's IEM rack via ART S8 3-way splitters.
- We provide a 16-channel snake, or venue may patch into our rack directly for FOH.
- No amp cabs used silent stage setup (except drums).
- Band can provide our own mics and XLR cables.
- Venue should provide mic stands and a suitable stage box.
- Venue should provide at least one 120V AC outlet near each setup location.
- The keyboard station requires two outlets.
- Power may be shared or combined if practical.
